## TALKING POINTS

### Things Above

“The meat of the Word isn’t knowledge. It isn’t information. It’s application. I would rather know 4 or 5 basic Truths of the Bible and really live those out than to know 1000s of things and apply nothing.” -Pastor Dan

### Leaning In and Living It Out

#### **Read Colossians 3:1-4**

*Paul says to set your mind on the things above, not on things that are on the earth.*  
What does this mean to you?

*Often we're more concerned about our establishing our kingdom rather than God's.*  
Why is this true?

*Paul calls us in this passage to do two things - to seek and to think.*  
Why are both important?

*Pastor Dan says, “Worry is a real indicator we are too invested in this world”.*  
How do we combat this? Discuss.

*Jesus tells us in the book of Matthew we are to seek the Kingdom of God first.*  
Why is this the key to REALLY living life now?

*As Christians, we should not live in fear of death.*  
Why? Discuss.

### Dig Deeper (Optional)

What does the phrase “your life is hidden with Christ in God” mean? Discuss.

Why did Paul use the specific statement, “where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God” in this passage?

How does this passage tie in with Colossians 2:12?
