Leaning In and Living It Out

Read Psalm 1

To be blessed is to be marked by God's favor, resulting in spiritual joy. How do you know you have God's favor? Discuss.

Blessed people have the right influences - focusing on the things of God, rather than the prevailing worldly system and icons. What worldly influencers would you be be better off distancing from? Discuss.

Blessed people abide in the Lord - they pursue Him and delight in His word. The result of this pursuit produces stability, fruitfulness, longevity and prosperity in our lives. How do you delight in God's word in the day-to-day? Discuss.

Blessed people have great value to God - not that they're perfect, but God is present in the midst of their imperfection. Do you see yourself as having great value to God? Discuss.

Blessed people can stand in confidence before the judgment of God. How do you know you can come before God with confidence? Discuss.

Blessed people have intimacy and protection with God. What is the difference between knowing about God, and having intimacy with Him? Discuss.

Dig Deeper (Optional)

The Psalm says, "But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and in His law he meditates day and night." What is Christian meditation? Discuss.
