## Leaning In and Living It Out

## **Read Psalm 96**

Psalm 96 is a universal call to worship God as creator, ruler and judge. It is intended to produce joy and evoke faith through worship of Him. What does worship mean to you? Discuss.

There are four keys to worshiping God in this Psalm - first, we are to believe rightly about who He is - that we honor and revere Him for His greatness and love. In a world confused about who God is, how do we know him rightly? Discuss.

Next, we are to bring gifts - not only do we give and it changes our hearts, but we give as a way to acknowledge His Authority over our lives.
Why is generosity not really about money? Discuss.

We are to approach him with submissive spirit in humility and awe. The word worship literally means "bow down".

What does the "fear of God" mean to you? Discuss.

We are to be bold about the Lord. How can you be bolder about your faith with others? Discuss.
