Psalm 63 - Confidence In God

“The meat of the Word isn’t knowledge. It isn’t information. It’s application. I would rather know 4 or 5 basic Truths of the Bible and really live those out than to know 1000s of things and apply nothing.” -Pastor Dan

Leaning In and Living It Out

Read Psalm 96

In Psalm 63, even though the bottom had dropped out of David's life and he was separated from his home and his sanctuary, he still expressed his confidence in God. What does worship mean to you? Discuss.

David describes his desire for God in a very powerful word *his desire for God is like being in a barren desert where there is no rain and he craves God like water.* In a world confused about who God is, how do we know him rightly? Discuss.

David was called a man after God's own heart *because he sought God intently, no matter his circumstances, whether successes or failures.* Why is generosity not really about money? Discuss.

We are to approach him with submissive spirit in humility and awe. The word worship literally means "bow down". What does the "fear of God" mean to you? Discuss.

We are to be bold about the Lord. How can you be bolder about your faith with others? Discuss.
