

Scripture Focus: Acts 6:1–7

Read Acts 6 .

Context Recap:

The early church was growing fast , but with growth came challenges. Widows were being overlooked in daily care, and the apostles called the people to step up.

Discussion:

- What stands out to you in this passage?
- Why do you think God allowed this problem to surface in the growing church?
- How do you see both practical and spiritual leadership at work here?

Small Moments, Big Impact

“You ever notice how some of the biggest moves of God started with really small moments of obedience?”

Reflect:

- Share a time when a small “yes” to God made a bigger impact than you expected.
- Why do you think we often overlook small opportunities to serve?
- What might God be asking you to step up in right now even if it feels small or unseen?

Step Up Where You See a Need

“It wasn’t flashy, but it mattered.”

Discussion:

- What needs do you see in our church, city, or neighborhood that might be easy to miss?
- How can we, as a group, help meet one of those needs?

- What's one way the Holy Spirit might be prompting you to act this week?

The Secret of a Thriving Church

“And the Word of God continued to increase, and the number of disciples multiplied greatly.” — Acts 6:7

Reflect:

- What do you think Luke meant by connecting serving with gospel growth?
- Why do you think “serving” often leads to spiritual multiplication?
- How does this reshape the way we think about “church success”?

The Big 3

“Step up to serve. Step out to witness. Step in to what God is doing.”

Discuss & Commit:

- Which of these three feels most natural to you right now? Which one stretches you most?
- What's one step you can take this week in one of these areas?

Practical On-Ramps:

1. Serve on a team. Where could your gifts make a difference?
2. Give to the campaign. How can generosity be part of your obedience?
3. Invite a friend. Who might God be putting on your heart to reach?
